Don't forget to apply sun cream to your child before school and send them to school with sun hats and a water bottle. Water bottles and sun hats are available from the school office. Prices above.


#### Film Club

The strange world of Roald Dahl's book is perfectly rendered using the painstaking craft of stop-motion animation.
