- Great stuff thanks

- Some children repeatedly picked to represent the school for sporting events, some children given an equal chance are told names are drawn from a hat but always the same names that get drawn
- Please could we know the teacher situation in year 1, parents are asking when a teacher will returning to the playground but no info from the school regarding this.
- Small issues, reading assessments need to be done more often

- Occasionally there is unavoidable disruption. (Q11)
- Would like the morning snack that we provide to vary (Pancakes/malt loaf/savoury muffins) as sometimes my daughter only has a small breakfast at home but hungry by mid-morning.
- As a parent of a child with a disability, I cannot thank or recommend Cranwell Primary School enough for all they do. - Mathletics causes us issues as I was taught differently to my daughter and if she ask for help I'm not sure I'm doing it right and it causes us arguments
- Excellent school
- Mathletics is a struggle for our son, the concentration required is beyond his personnel limits which are often an area of frustration for him.
- The school is extremely supportive, all staff are friendly. Both kids are thriving!
- After a rough few weeks before Christmas my daughter has finally settled again and seems happier than ever, she has a smile on her face and enjoys coming to school- Thank you Cranwell
- Excellent so far
- More writing for homework would improve spelling
- I feel that some of the homework tasks are beyond the capabilities of a 6 year old without intensive adult input and support, e.g. make a wreath, cook African food etc. While my daughter has enjoyed the activity itself, it has involved quite a bit of parental prep-work and use of family time and I sometimes feel if the child is not able to do a task then it is perhaps ending up as homework for the parent! I'm committed to supporting the extension of learning she does at school and we put full effort in to the tasks, but I do feel some of them are a little advanced for her age group capabilities.
- At times I think there is too much homework, not that my child doesn't complete it. It impacts on weekends due to both working, also weekdays as my child engages in activities after school. My child reads every night independently.
