


Parental Questionnaire

- Very happy with the school
- An absolutely amazing school and extremely happy to have my child attend.
- Fantastic school, both girls have thrived and done so well and love being here.
- Great school and staff. Very happy that my child is well equipped to move onto next phase of her education.
- Blue Badge parking for disabled children needs significant attention.
- Front desk staff customer service skills need addressing as I have encountered rude attitude on more than one occasion.
- Our children only joined this school in January; already our son has had immediate support put in place to support his development. Regular feedback given. Massive thank you to Mrs XX!
- I am truly happy that my son has had Cranwell Primary School as his prep school for year 7 and onwards.
- Sometimes we have to use social media to confirm details of activities etc. as info can be sketchy.
- We are really pleased with this school
- Parent to teacher communication could be more frequent.
- The homework in general never takes 30 minutes. It always takes a lot longer and the amount is considerable over the holidays. In all areas, other than homework, we are delighted with the school and teacher.
- Excellent school my kids love it here, it's very family orientated and has helped us a lot over the last few years and I have recently recommended the school to a friend.
- Volume of homework is at times a little much. He sometimes struggles to complete homework in the evenings due to general levels of fatigue, meaning that work is finished to a poor standard. This is not helped by both parents working full time.
- Really pleased with my child's progress, he has learnt so much since starting.
- Too much homework given to the children.
- Children are taught in a completely different way to the way we (adults) were. An advice pack, especially in the early years would be helpful to ensure parents can fully support homework.
- The office staff are lovely.
- Needs more after school clubs for KS1.
- My child is always complaining of being disturbed by another child walking around the class. A lot of homework, but is age appropriate.
- I have been so impressed with the massive increase in all aspects of her work since starting school. The communication from school is excellent.
- I feel that it would be fairer to choose a variety of children to represent the school at outside sporting events as the same children are chosen each time.
- The ladies in the office answer questions promptly and courteously each time – thank you.
- Sometimes the quantity of homework seems excessive and we spend hours at it rather than the recommended timescales. Also difficult to 'keep up' as a working family.
- I absolutely love the pictures of our child at work that Miss Xx has included. It makes it more personal. Thank you for all the work you put into our children's learning.
- Just an idea – would classes do more school trips to enhance their learning?

- Too many trainee teachers who don't seem to be given enough supervision. Often spellings / grammatical errors in homework which is generally printed straight offline.
- Cranwell Primary is an outstanding school that we are very happy with for all of our children.
- The staff are very supportive, and go above and beyond what parents expect of them.
- Sometimes feel information could be sent out earlier
- An outstanding school that has provided excellent support to my daughter since her arrival 12 months ago. They have set great foundations in the principle of lifelong learning because learning here at Cranwell is fun.
- Not always coming home with his homework, so unsure how he is being told what to bring home.
- Too much homework
- More feedback if child needs extra help.
- Has only been at Cranwell for 4 weeks. We have seen a huge improvement. Thank you
- We are not aware of any bullying issues
- Thanks for your support. Great work
- Excellent my son has settled quickly into the school.
- Cannot fault the school in any way. All staff including office staff are fabulous, approachable and helpful.
- I have no experience of any bullying at all. We are new to school (Jan 16) and are absolutely delighted at how well she has been integrated and made very welcome.
- My daughter (Foundation) is desperate to do after school clubs but is too young.
- Mrs XX is truly wonderful! So approachable. I feel the homework is on the heavy side compared to other schools, can make the children overwhelmed / unmotivated and see it as a chore rather than positive.
- All 3 of our children have benefitted from excellent care and education at this school; I would recommend Cranwell Primary School to any parent.
