

Key Stage 1 Sports Day will commence at 1:15PM. This event is scheduled to finish around 3pm when children will return to their classrooms before being collected as normal.

If your child is taking part in Key Stage 1 Sports Day and you would like to join them for a picnic, you are welcome to do so from 12 o'clock. Please note, we do have children in school with allergies and would appreciate you being sensitive towards this, avoiding bringing in any nuts or shellfish.

If a pre ordered hot lunch is still required, those children will be able to join you on the playground once they have finished eating in the hall.

On the Day - All children are to come to school in PE kit; trainers or plimsolls, shorts and a t-shirt in their house team colour. It would also be advisable to wear hats and plenty of

sun cream as well as bringing a full water bottle as the fantastic weather is due to continue.

Games Afternoon


